Most of these requests do not meet those stipulations and, as such, are outside the scope of Fredricks Outdoor's advertising budget.

Our Program

However, we have a workaround. We offer each of you an opportunity to help us help you. Please register your organization's information with us ([link](#)). Our team will review your organization for need, merit, and other factors. If approved, you will receive a notice of approval from us, along with your registration number.

After that, all you need to do is put your organization's name and registration number on the attached certificate. Give that certificate to anyone who may wish to purchase products or services from Fredricks Outdoor and, for any monies they spend with Fredricks Outdoor when presenting that certificate, your organization will receive 2% of the total amount received.

As an example: If you know someone who wants a tractor, and they spend \$20K with us, then present the coupon, your organization will receive \$400. If they spend \$100K, you will receive \$2000, and so on. Ultimately, the more you successfully promote us, the more we promote you.
